SUPPORT

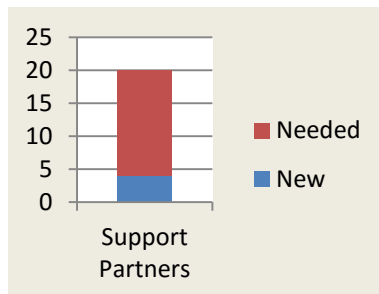
