What a first month! We have been able to accomplish almost all of our set-up tasks, from obtaining a vehicle to getting internet and receiving our shipment. After two weeks of negotiating with Guatemalan customs, our belongings were released to us and we were able to begin setting up our home. Piper and Kamden were thrilled to have toys to play with and their beds after sleeping on the floor for three weeks.

God has placed several veteran missionaries in our path. This has been a blessing to us as we are working to gain an understanding of culture and ministry here. Presently, we have observed a few different ministries and are praying for God's guidance as to where to begin a work when we have obtained an efficient use of the language.

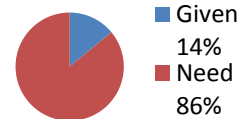
