Together they have joined a group of neighborhood women who meet for coffee each month and work together to help each other save money. Piper and Kamden are doing really well, making friends and adjusting to the language and cultural differences. While they haven’t learned much Spanish yet, toys and donuts transcend language and culture. Every evening a local bread maker brings his truck into our neighborhood and all of the children run to the truck to see if it is donut day and to get their fingers on their own sprinkled, chocolaty stickiness! as we partner for this great missionary endeavor.

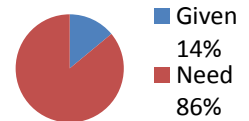
